- Students opting for courses at BHS ONLY should make **FIVE** choices; FOUR preferred options and ONE reserve option. Number your preferred options [1], [2], [3] & [4] IN PRIORITY ORDER. Put [R] against your reserve option.
- If you wish to take a course at UCM, please make only **THREE** choices in Box 1: TWO preferred options and ONE reserve. Number your preferred choices [1] & [2], and your reserve choice [R]. Then follow instructions for completing Box 2.
- You may choose no more than TWO DT options.
- If you are **not** currently in 9E and wish to take Biology, Chemistry & Physics as separate GCSEs, make Separate Sciences one of your preferred choices. (Nb. Students currently in 9E will automatically take Biology, Chemistry & Physics, unless otherwise agreed with the Science Faculty Leader).
